Early Spring/Early Fall

arugula	lettuce

WARM WEATHER CROPS

Late Spring/Summer

beans
cucumbers
eggplant
lima beans
melons
peppers

spinach (New Zealand)
squash, summer and winter
sweet potatoes

SHORT SEASON CROPS

good for succession planting

arugula	onions
bush beans	peas
beets	radishes
cabbage	scallions

TRANSPLANTS

no direct-seeding

tomatoes	leeks
peppers	cabbage
eggplant	sweet potatoes
broccoli	brussel sprouts

SHALLOW ROOTS

handle less water well

legumes
crucifers

LEAST SPACE-CONSUMING

good for raised beds
